## To Qualify for Massachusetts Residency

A resident is defined as a student who has lived in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for at least six continuous months preceding the beginning date of the academic periods for which he/she seeks to enroll. All international students attending this college with a student visa must pay non-resident tuition. The following criteria shall be an indication of residency:

- for unemancipated persons, the residency of parents, having custody, within Massachusetts;
- certified copies of federal and state income tax returns;
- permanent employment;
- reliance on Massachusetts sources for financial support;
- continuous physical presence in Massachusetts during period when not an enrolled student
- military home of record

## To Qualify for the New England Regional Student Program

Mount Wachusett Community College participates in the New England Regional Student Program (NERSP). This program, administered by the New England Board of Higher Education, offers qualified out-of-state residents the benefits of reduced tuition to study at any of the publicly supported institutions of higher education in New England. Massachusetts's resident tuition, plus 50 percent, is charged to out-of-state students if a specific program is not offered in the student's home state. NERSP pays the same fees as all other students. Contact Admissions to learn if your state and program qualifies.
