Requirements - ALL APPLICANTS

Applicants are responsible for all costs associated with their education including textbooks and transportation. Financial aid is not available. Applications received after deadlines will be reviewed on a case by case basis. Course selection bulletins and college catalogs are available on our website at www.mwcc.edu. Submission requirements are as follows:

- Return this application with a \$10.00 Application Fee (non-refundable)
- Applicants must be 16 years of age or older
- Applicants must complete college placement testing and meet all pre-requisite requirements for selected course(s)
(testing appointments will be assigned once application has been processed)
- Assessment test score requirements:
English proficiency: must place into English 101, Reading proficiency: score of 69 on the CPT Reading, Comprehension assessment sentence skills: 68 or greater on CPT SS assessment required, and Math proficiency: must place into MAT 126. Students who do not meet the above testing guidelines may be permitted to take foundation level courses with the approval of their high school.
- Official current high school transcript with calculated GPA (based on 4.0 scale)
Applications received after deadline will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

- Current high school/home school student seeking an additional academic challenge, but does not intend to transfer course credit back to the high school to meet graduation requirements.
